SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Ballet Wolcott Scholarship is designed to promote students' disciplined study of high-quality dance instruction. Scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need, artistic ability, dedication, and availability.

Parents and students should fill out each portion of the form and mail it to Ballet Wolcott, PO Box 151, Wolcott, VT 05680 by April 30, 2019. Electronic files may be sent to Brandy@BalletWolcott.com.

Awards for summer programs will be up to \$150 OR not exceed 50% of the total tuition. Only severe hardship cases will be reviewed and/or awarded for scholarships above 60%. Applicants will hear from Ballet Wolcott by June 30, 2019.

ELIGIBILITY

Students may be between 3 & 18 years of age.

August Intensive Students must be 12 or older and have taken classes in ballet for at least 2 years.

Students must have a good attendance record, show talent, promise and dedication.

Student's family must have a financial need.

Students and Parents must fill out a registration form and a scholarship application and return them to Ballet Wolcott by April 30, 2019.

Applicants must sign and adhere to the conditions of their Payment Plan Form and/or Scholarship Agreement.

Students who have outstanding balances may be ineligible for scholarships.
