

Costumes: What you need to bring and What you need to know!

Clara, Clara's Friends: clean & intact, footed pink tights (If you are wearing convertible tights, please, tuck the tights in to your shoes.), clean pink pointe shoes or ballet slippers (see Brandy about this); NUDE—AND NO OTHER COLORS—leotard and/or bras & panties for those with quick changes; hair with the top pulled back, and hanging down in back in ringlets

Party Girls, Dolls, Maids: clean & intact, footed pink tights (If you are wearing convertible tights, please, tuck the tights in to your shoes.); pink ballet slippers; nude or light colored leo for Maids; Dolls wear pink leos; hair with the top pulled back, and hanging down in back in ringlets

; Kids' Tap & Jazz wear tap shoes for tap dance.

Fritz Fritz's Friends, Party Boys: black ballet slippers or jazz shoes; Girls-hair in tucked French braid(s); Boys' hair should be neat and off of face

Herr Stahlbaum, Frau Stahlbaum, Herr Drosselmeyer, Party Parents:

Ladies: pany hose/nude tights, character shoes or low heels/pumps, Victorian hairstyle (if possible)

Men: Check with Charlene.

Snow Queen, Snow Flakes, Spanish, Arabian, Chinese, Russian, Mirliton, Dew, Drop, Sugar Plum Fairy: NUDE—AND NO OTHER COLORS—leotard and/or bras & panties for those with quick changes, hair in buns or a hairstyle that is approved by the costume designer,

Snow Fairies: pink ballet slippers, clean & intact, footed pink tights (If you are wearing convertible tights, please, tuck the tights in to your shoes.), hair in buns

Flowers: pink ballet slippers; clean & intact, footed pink tights (If you are wearing convertible tights, please, tuck the tights in to your shoes.), hair in buns, You may wear a nude leo for modesty, if you like.

Costume Guidelines:

Never eat in costume.

Check the costume to see if your name is in it. Make sure it is yours before you put it on.

Remove all jewelry, including watches and hair ties on the wrist.

If your costume comes with jewelry, wear only what the costume designer gives permission for.

Never pull on stray threads. Have a grown-up carefully cut them.

If you have a costume problem (damage, doesn't fit, can't find it), get help from a grown-up immediately.

Hang up all costumes when you are done using them. Do not drape them over the seats or leave them lying around.
